
## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS FOR RECORD PLAYER

## INITIAL SET-UP:

- 1. Slowly rotate the Turntable Platter clockwise until the hole in the Platter is directly over the Transit Screw (A) underneath the Platter.
- 2. Insert a screwdriver into the hole and rotate the Transit Screw (A) clockwi se until it is all the way dowm.
- 3. Turn the Transit Screw (B) clockwise until it is all the way down.



NOTE: Before initial play, unlock the Tonearm and raise the Cueing Lever. -Move the Tonearm towards the Spindle until the auto return mechanism isengaged. Allow the Tonearm to return to it's rest position and lower -the Cueing Lever.

## USING THE RECORD PLAYER:

- Unlock the Clip holding the Tonearm and remove the Stylus Protector Cap bypulling it forward.
- Set the Speed switch to either "33" or "45" depending on the record to be played. To play a 45rpm record, the 45rpm Adaptor must be placed over the-Spindle.
- 3. Place a record on the Turntable Platter.
- Raise the Cueing Lever and position the Tonearm above the desired track onthe record. The Turntable Platter will automatically start rotating.
- 5. Gently lower the Cueing lever.
- At the end of the record, the Tonearm will return automatically to it's rest position and the player will shut off.
- 7. When not in use, clamp the Tonearm at it's rest position using the Clip.

CAUTION: Manually turning or obstructing the movement of the Turntable Platter may damage the Record Player.
